“LA ‘IN’ JUSTA” SPECTACLE

“La ‘In’ Justa” is the GREAT DEBUT of the 2014 season. It is well known for its beauty, realism and continuous interaction between the actors and the elements.

When the Reign is at risk, the king, afraid of his daughters and his lands destiny, decides to search a worthy successor to the throne among the bravest Knights of the Kingdom. In order to choose who has the best qualities, he organizes a Spectacular Fight where the Knights have to fight until the King reaches a decision. However, the Princess Ingrid is not happy with the idea of being forced into marriage, considering it ‘Un’ Fair, and tries to discourage the Knights with her acid comments until one of them makes her a proposal that seems interesting.

This Spectacle is formed by a group of SIX MEDIEVAL KNIGHTS in their fighting armors, and SIX HORSES, each one carrying horse blankets and metal details that match the colours of the Knight that is riding them. The Horses are driven by Segway PTs, hidden under the blankets, creating the feeling of a real animal thanks to the sound effects they include. The X2 Segway PT models are ready for any ground and extremely easy to drive. Thanks to the upgrades implemented for the Spectacle, they can be driven without using the hands, providing the drivers with a greater freedom of movements to interact with the audience.

After them, a small TOWER (transported on a vehicle hidden under its base) carries THE KING and THE PRINCESS, who have to decide which Knights will fight to prove worthy for the Kingdom. Both are provided with a ‘In-Head’ sound system that will help them narrate the events.

Each Knight carries a powerful sound system that will allow, thanks to a system of broadcasting and reception (the Tower is the broadcaster), to play a soundtrack that will carry the audience to the Medieval age, encouraging them to participate with their cheers in each fight.
